Intro to SME Tools Report

The enterprise software market has been growing rapidly, shaped by COVID-19. This report looks at how the employees of small and medium-size businesses in the US and UK use enterprise software – how they access it, which apps are on their go-to list, and whether they are happy with them.

We hope this report will provide useful insights for developers who want to create better software for a modern workplace, and for managers who want to make effective decisions choosing software for employees.



Which statement describes your current working arrangement the best?


39% of the employees in the US and 48% in the UK are enrolled in the hybrid model that combines both in-office and remote work. About 27% of the employees on both continents work remotely all the time while a little over 20% work strictly from the office.



For 27%, their work app toolkit gets updated annually. 9% of the respondents admitted that they use the same apps from year to year.



How often does the set of desktop applications on your work computer refresh?







Microsoft dominates the collaboration market






Enterprise app stores lead the choice

How often does the set of desktop applications on your work computer refresh? **39%** of the respondents indicated the apps they use for work come from the company's "internal app store" while 49% use the apps pre-installed on their work computer. 18% either purchase apps on their own or use trial versions.












Microsoft also wins the British hearts

Which one of the desktop applications you've mentioned you like the most?


44% of the UK SME workers like Microsoft apps the most when talking about the software they enjoy working with. The US employees are more diversified with their choice, with 20% enjoying Microsoft apps, 10% – Google apps, and the rest – many other apps.




Desktop apps dominate global workspace






Easy UX is the key for enterprise apps





25% of the employees on both continents are overwhelmed with the number of apps. At the same time, 66% of the respondents say they are okay with the number of apps they have to work with.





