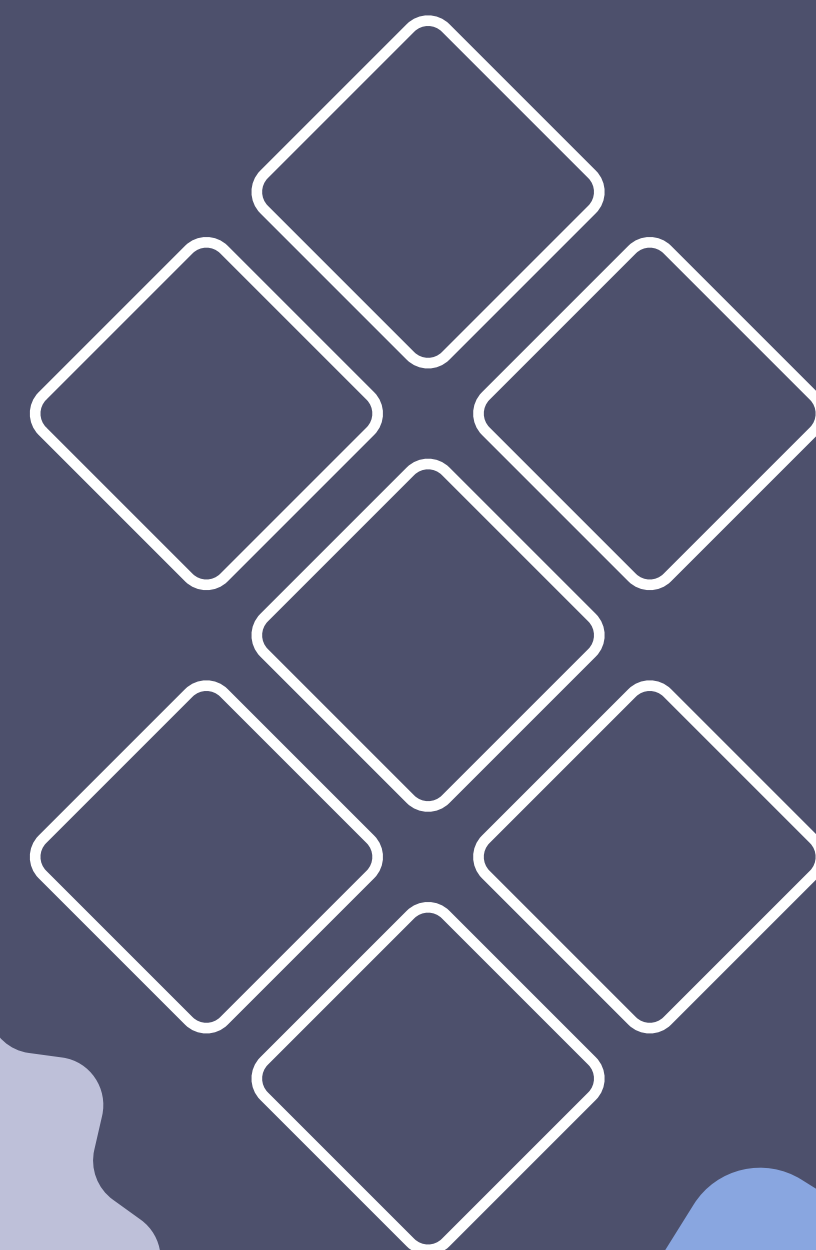


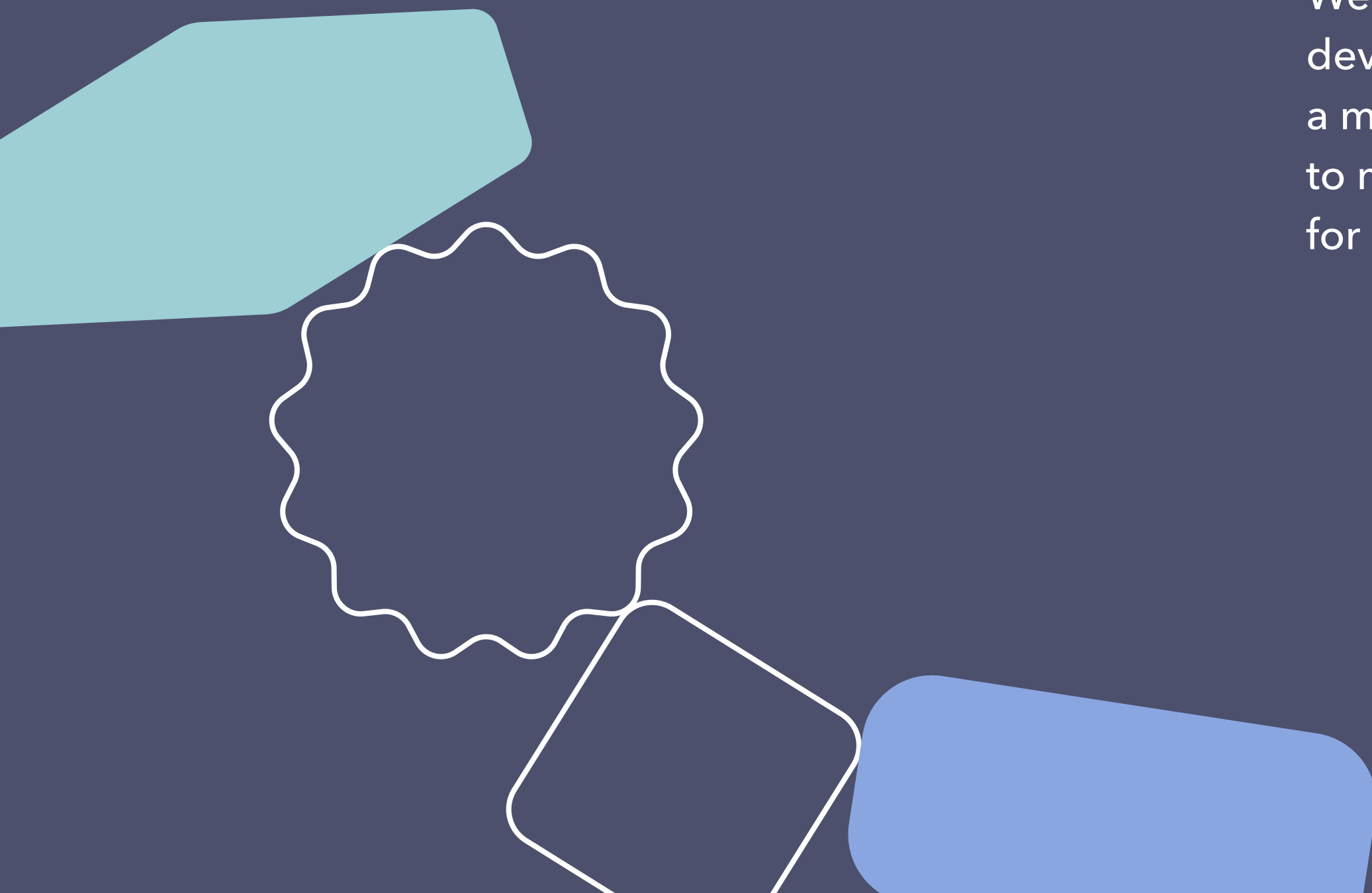
# SMALL & MEDIUM ENTERPRISE (SME) TOOLS REPORT 2021



# Intro to SME Tools Report

The enterprise software market has been growing rapidly, shaped by COVID-19. This report looks at how the employees of small and medium-size businesses in the US and UK use enterprise software – how they access it, which apps are on their go-to list, and whether they are happy with them.

We hope this report will provide useful insights for developers who want to create better software for a modern workplace, and for managers who want to make effective decisions choosing software for employees.



# Key Takeaways

65% of the SME employees in the US and 75% of employees in the UK use a Windows computer at work

50% of small and medium enterprises in the US and UK use Microsoft apps for team communication/collaboration

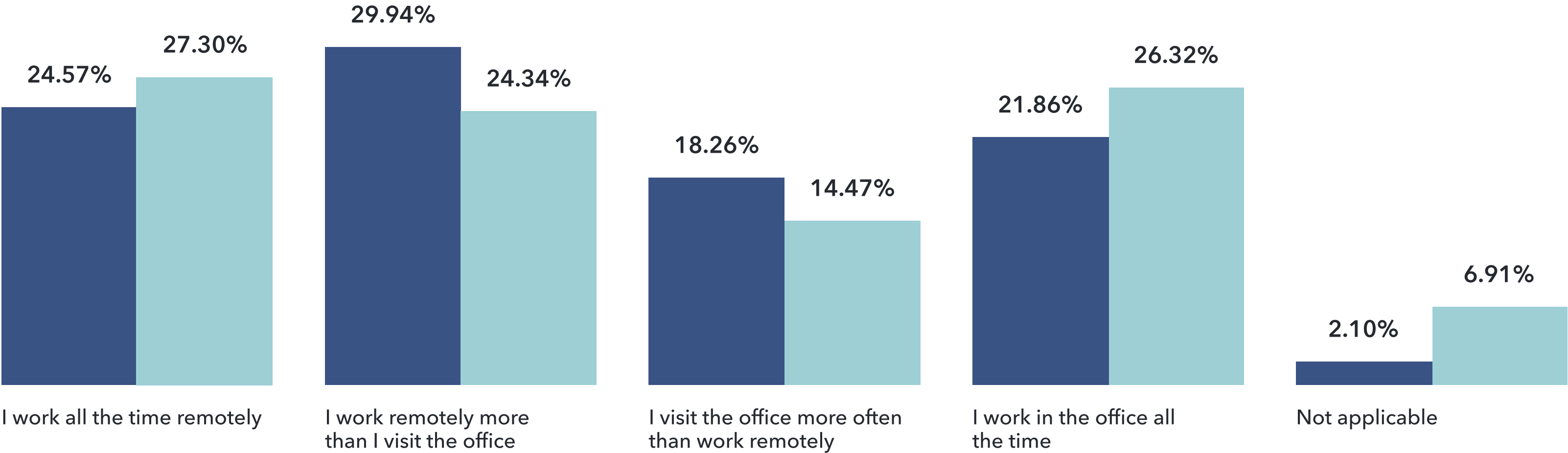
39% of the respondents both in the US and UK indicated they choose apps for work from the company's "internal app store"

# Hybrid work is the new normal

? Which statement describes your current working arrangement the best?



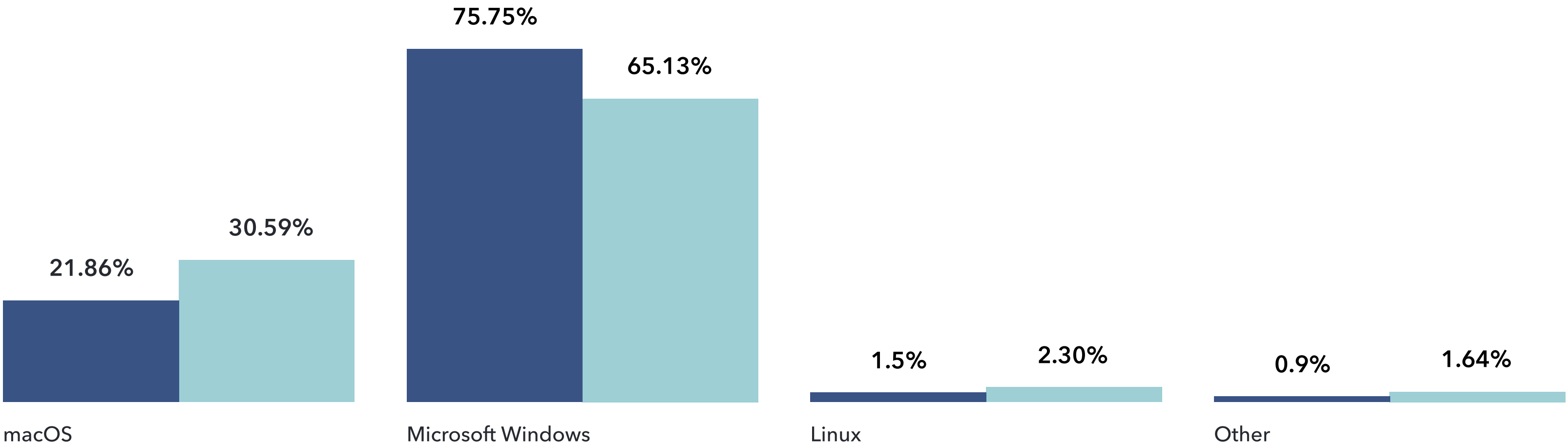
39% of the employees in the US and 48% in the UK are enrolled in the hybrid model that combines both in-office and remote work. About 27% of the employees on both continents work remotely all the time while a little over 20% work strictly from the office.



# Windows dominates workstations across the globe

65% of the employees in the US and 75% in the UK use a Windows computer at work, while 31% and 22% respectively work on Macs.

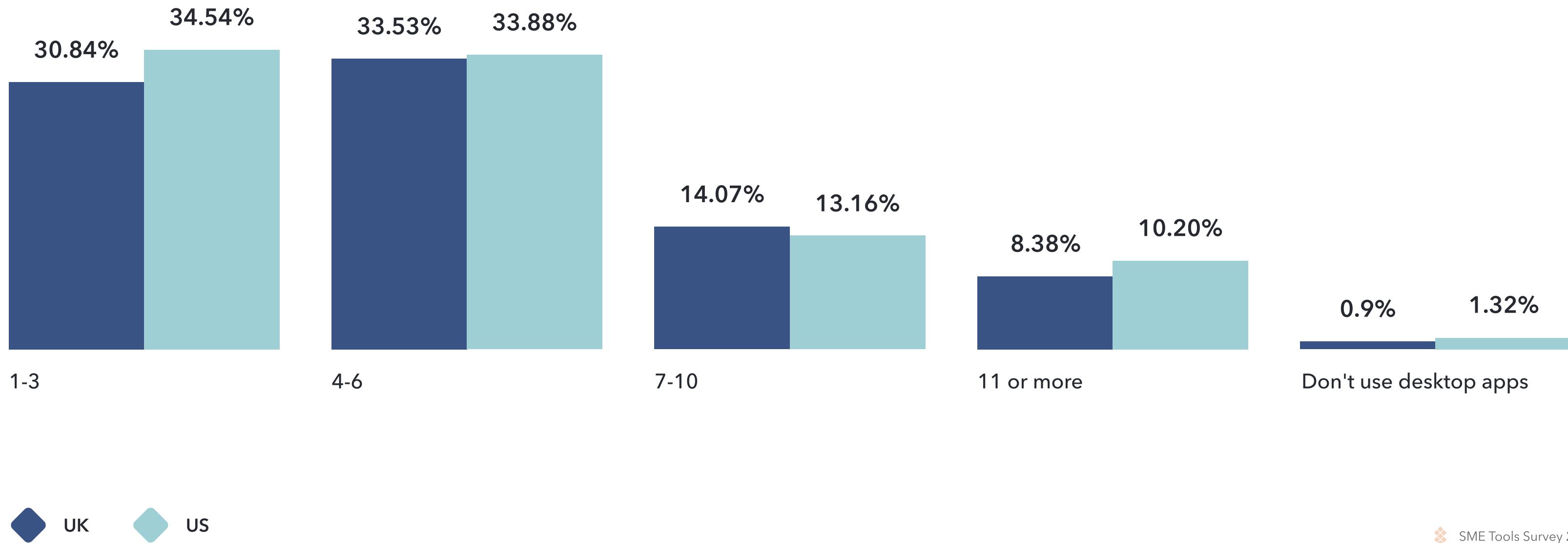
? Which desktop operating system do you use at work?



# SME worker's app arsenal

? How many desktop applications on your work desktop computer/laptop do you use daily on average? Screen reader support enabled.

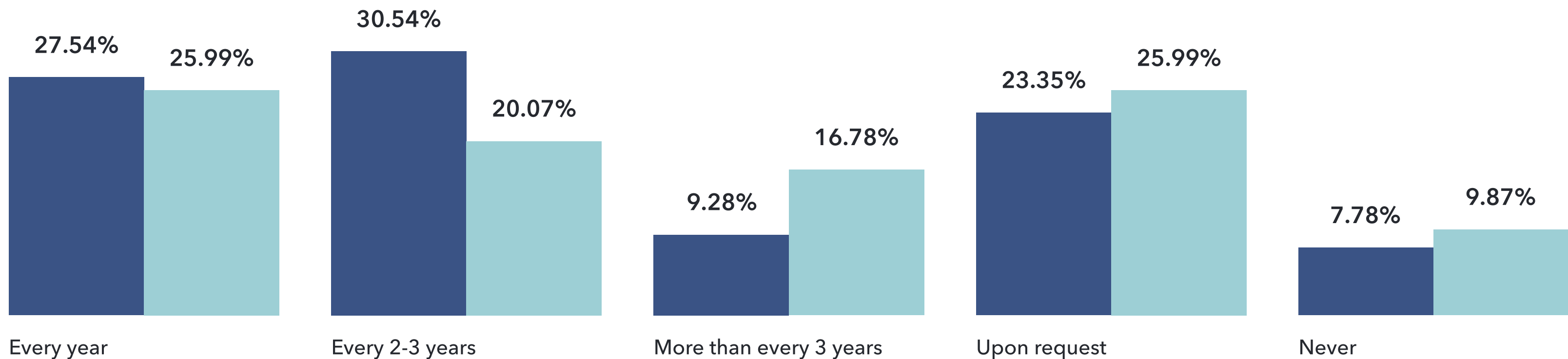
More than 60% of the respondents use up to 6 apps on their work desktop/laptop daily while about 10% use more than 10 apps.



# SME tools are not set in stone

For 27%, their work app toolkit gets updated annually. 9% of the respondents admitted that they use the same apps from year to year.

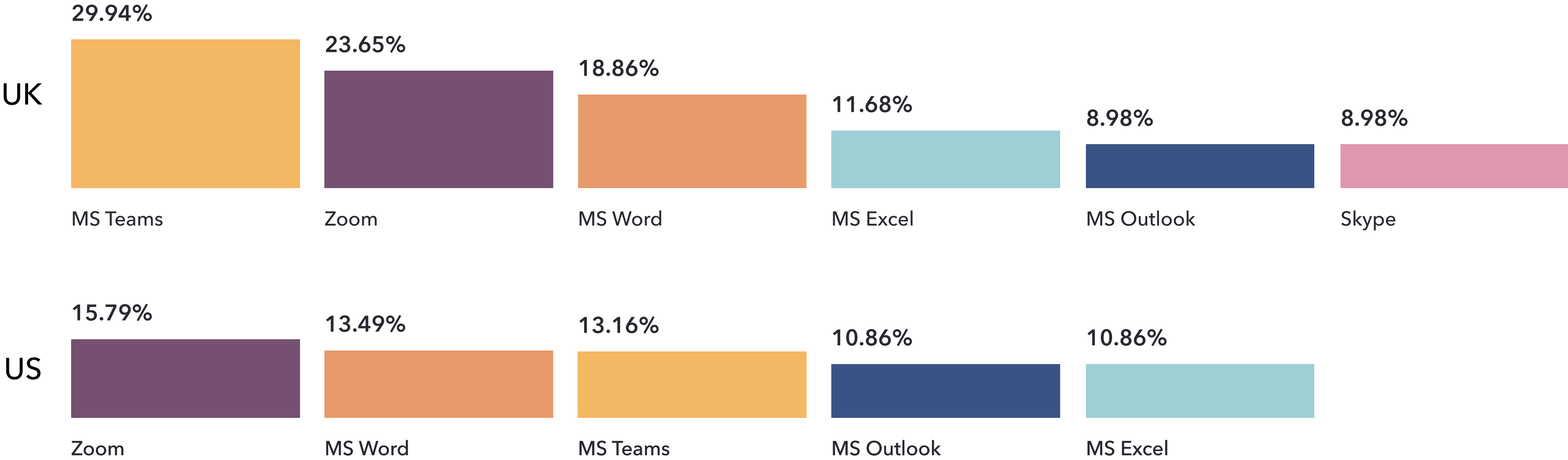


# Microsoft dominates the collaboration market



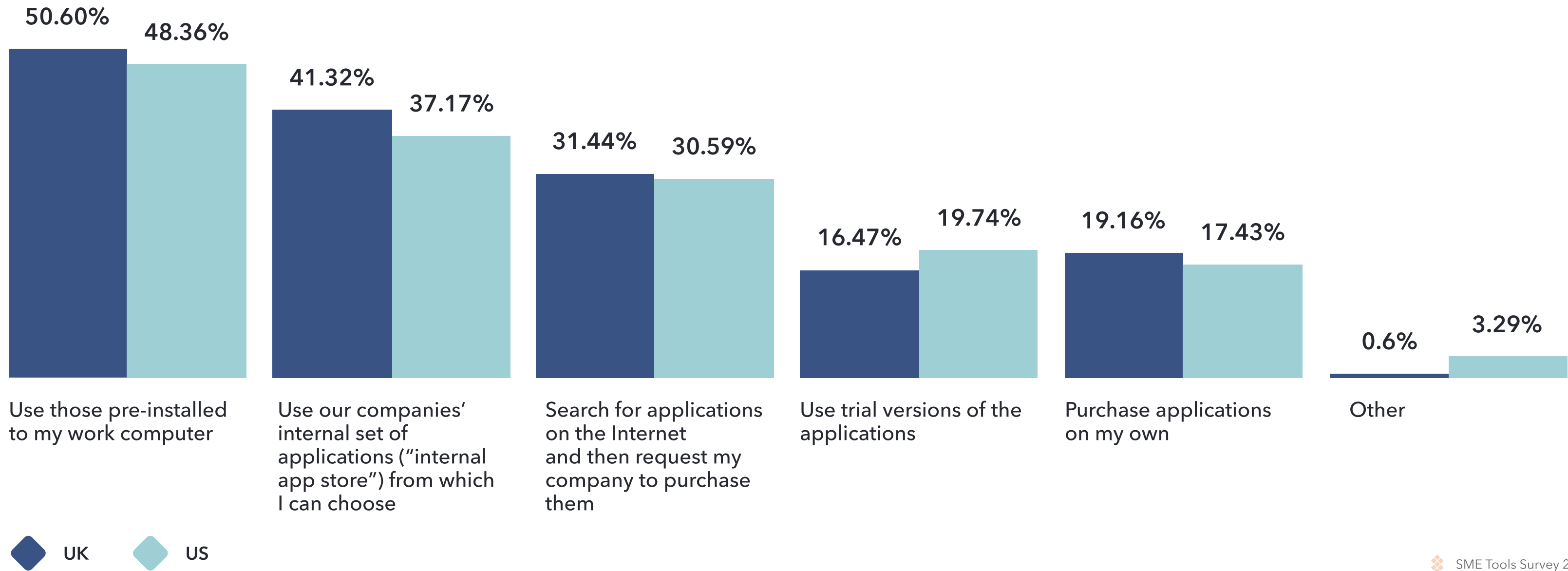
Please list 2 to 5 desktop apps you have on your work computer and use for team communication/collaboration

Microsoft, Zoom, and Skype are the most popular team communication/collaboration software providers, with the former dominating both in the US and UK.



# Enterprise app stores lead the choice

? How often does the set of desktop applications on your work computer refresh?

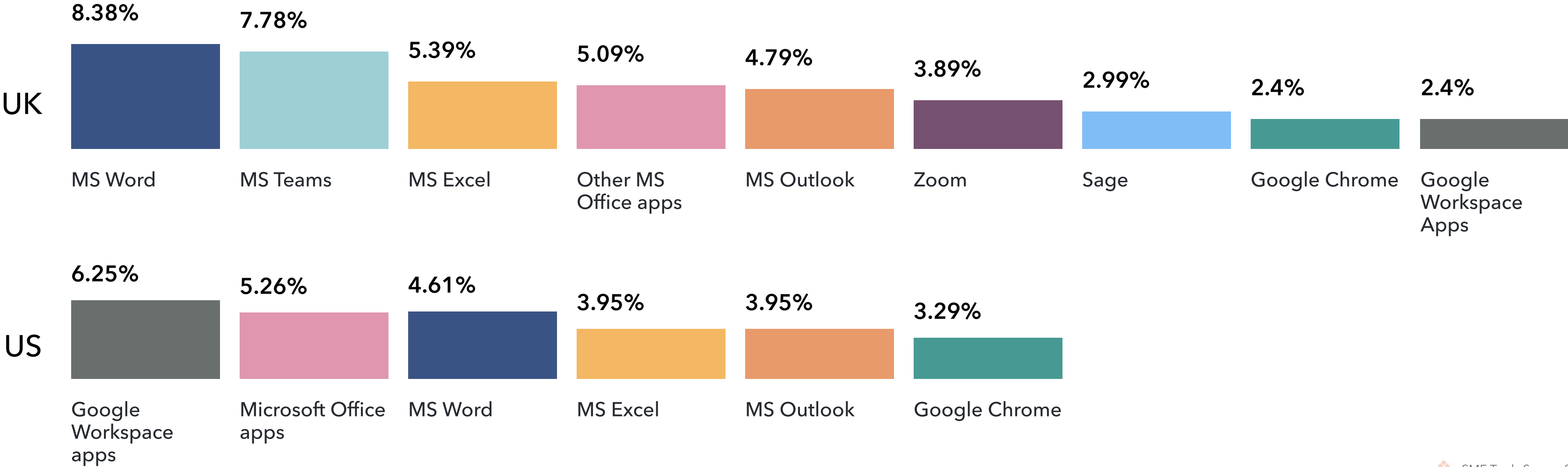


39% of the respondents indicated the apps they use for work come from the company's "internal app store" while 49% use the apps pre-installed on their work computer. 18% either purchase apps on their own or use trial versions.

# Microsoft also wins the British hearts

? Which one of the desktop applications you've mentioned you like the most?

44% of the UK SME workers like Microsoft apps the most when talking about the software they enjoy working with. The US employees are more diversified with their choice, with 20% enjoying Microsoft apps, 10% – Google apps, and the rest – many other apps.

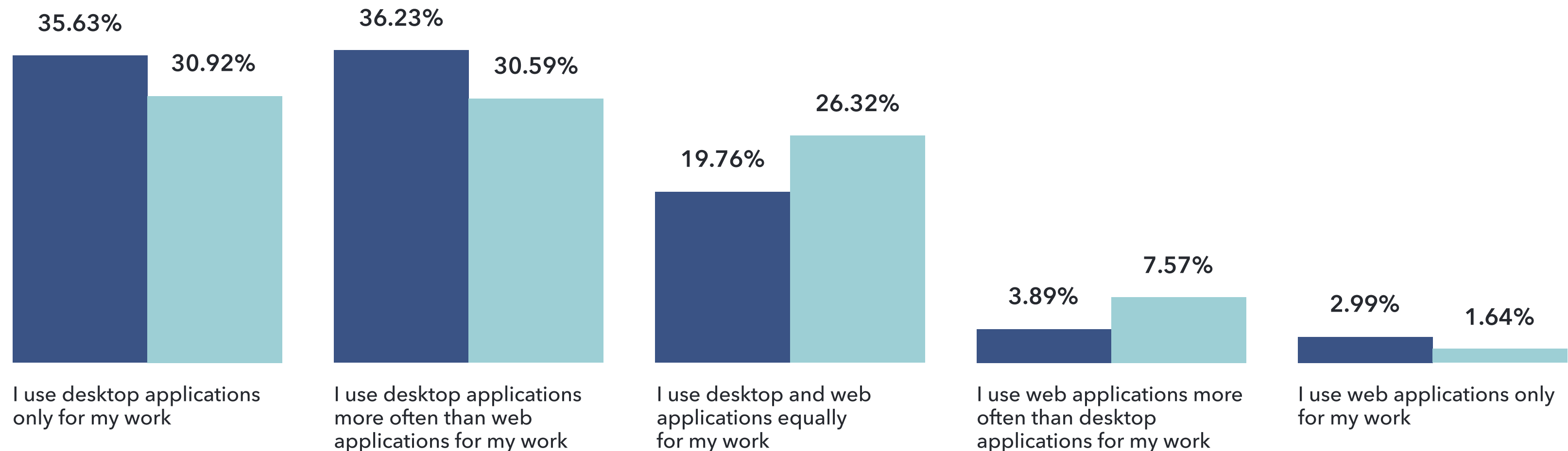


# Desktop apps dominate global workspace



Which of the following statements describes your use of applications the best?

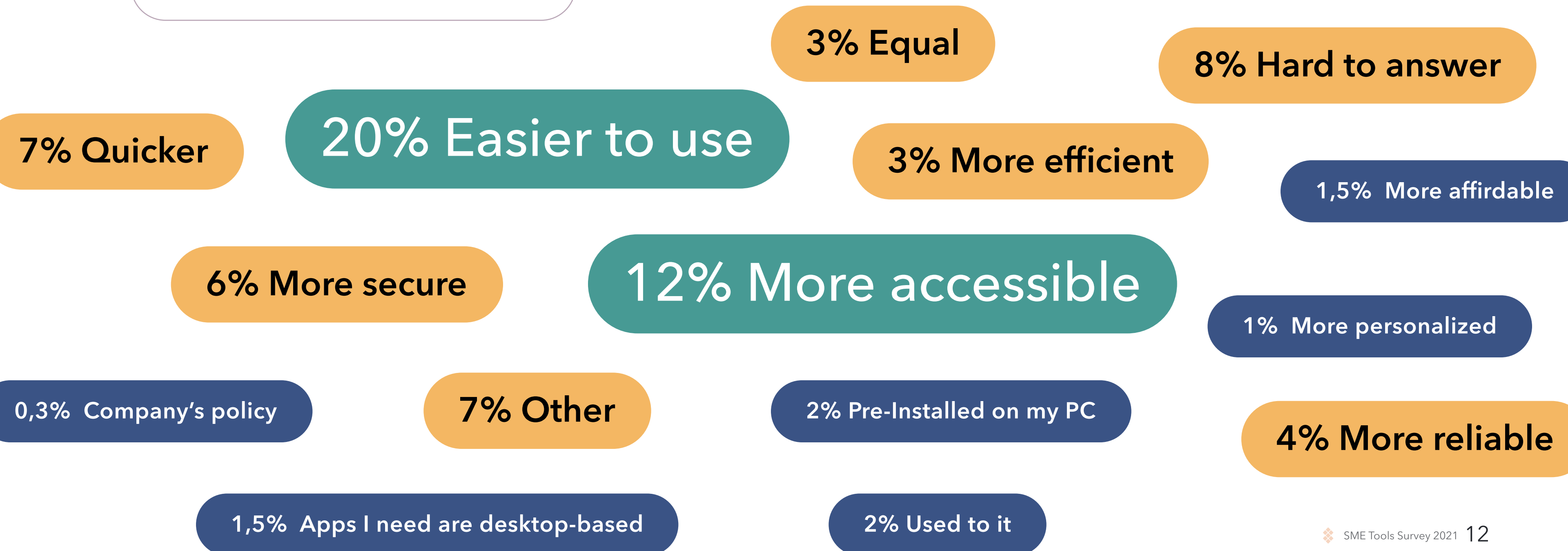
62% of the respondents in the US and 72% in the UK prefer to use desktop applications only or more often than web ones at work. Just 7% in the US and 4% in the UK use web applications more often than the desktop ones.

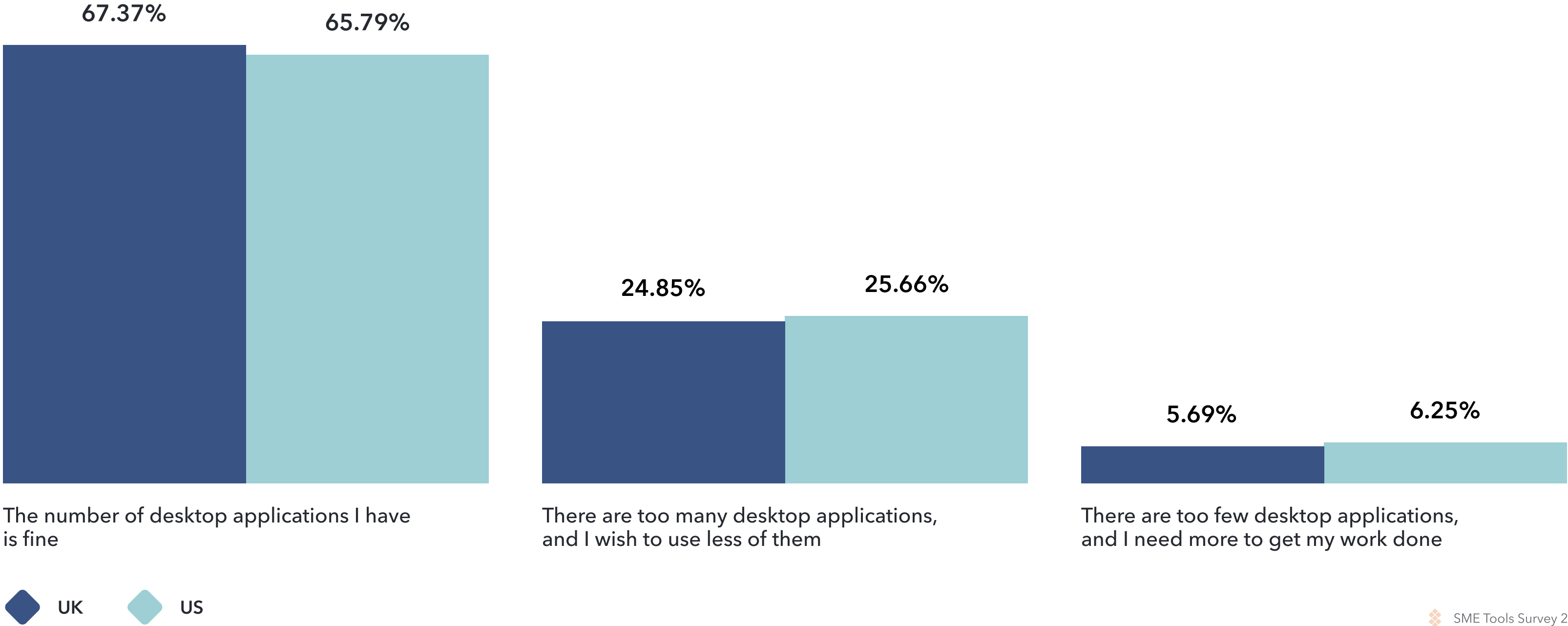

# App fatigue is real

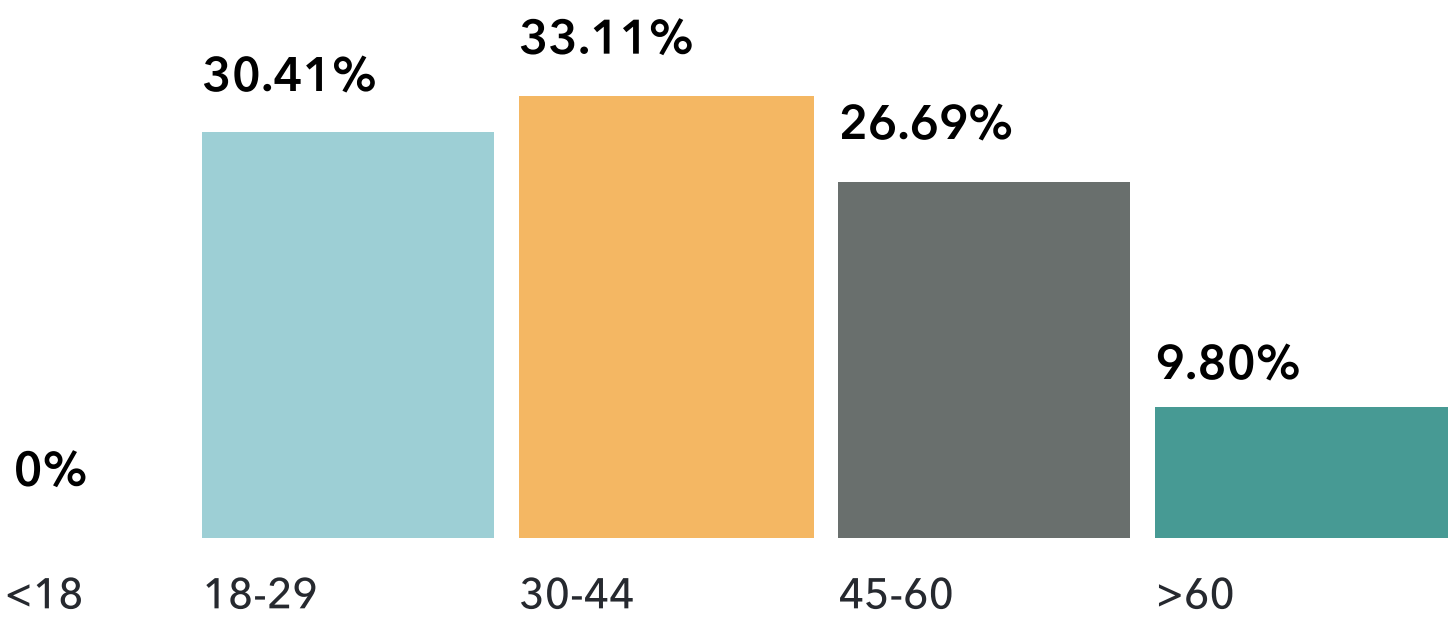
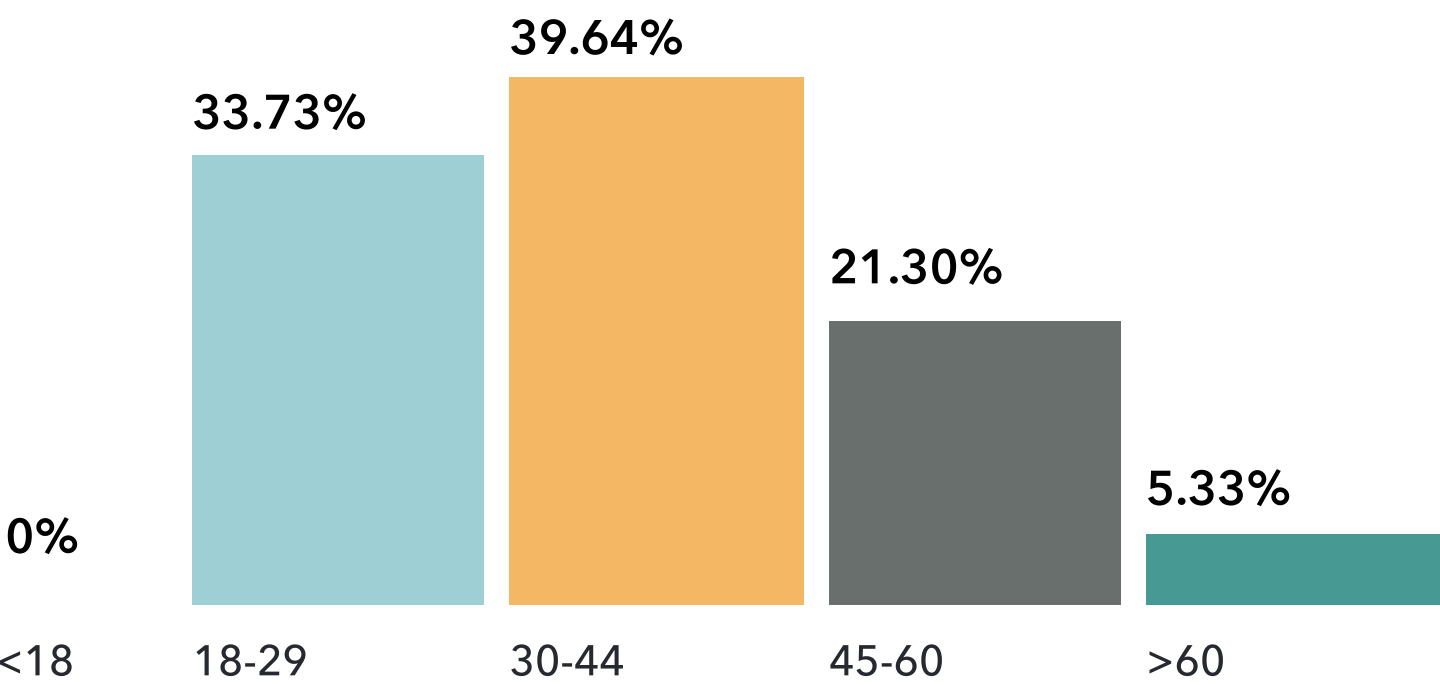
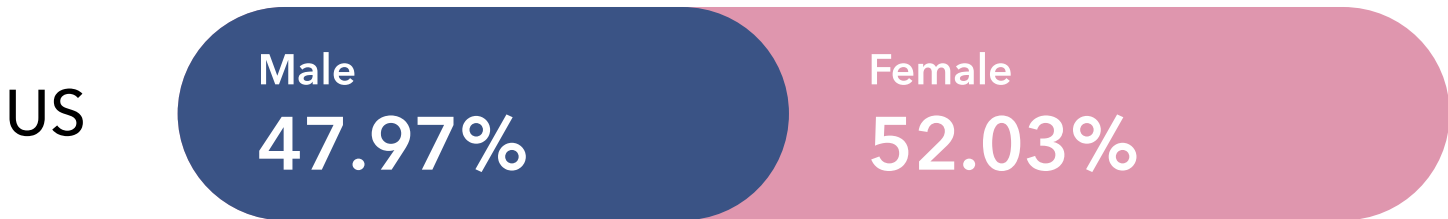
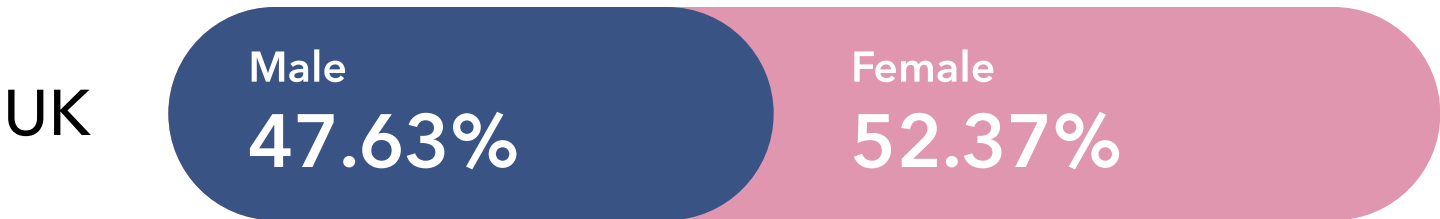
? How do you assess the number of desktop applications you have installed on your computer?

25% of the employees on both continents are overwhelmed with the number of apps. At the same time, 66% of the respondents say they are okay with the number of apps they have to work with.



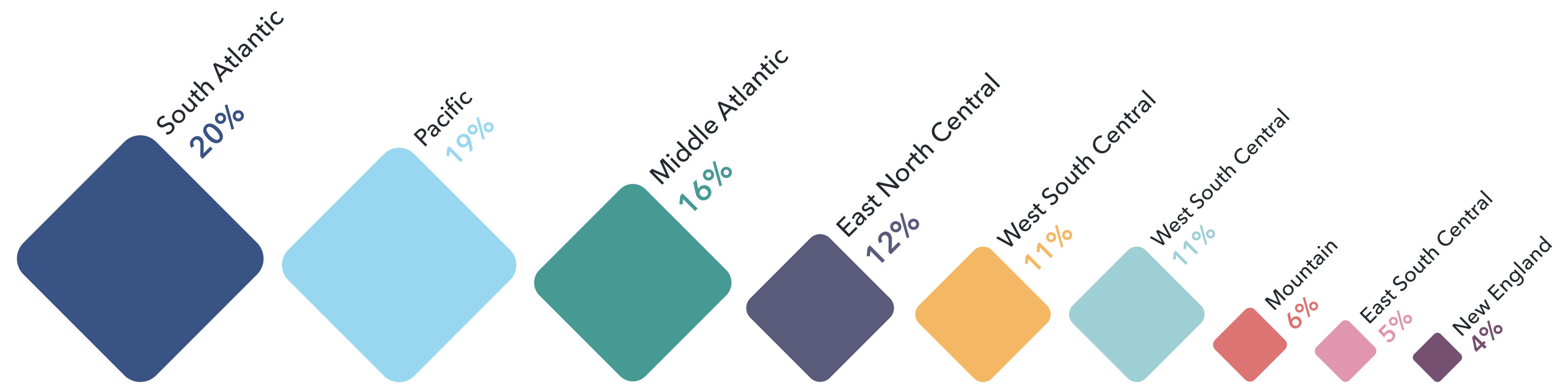
# Audience

The survey had 304 participants from the US and 334 participants from the UK, all of which indicated they work for small/medium enterprises, up to 250 employees.



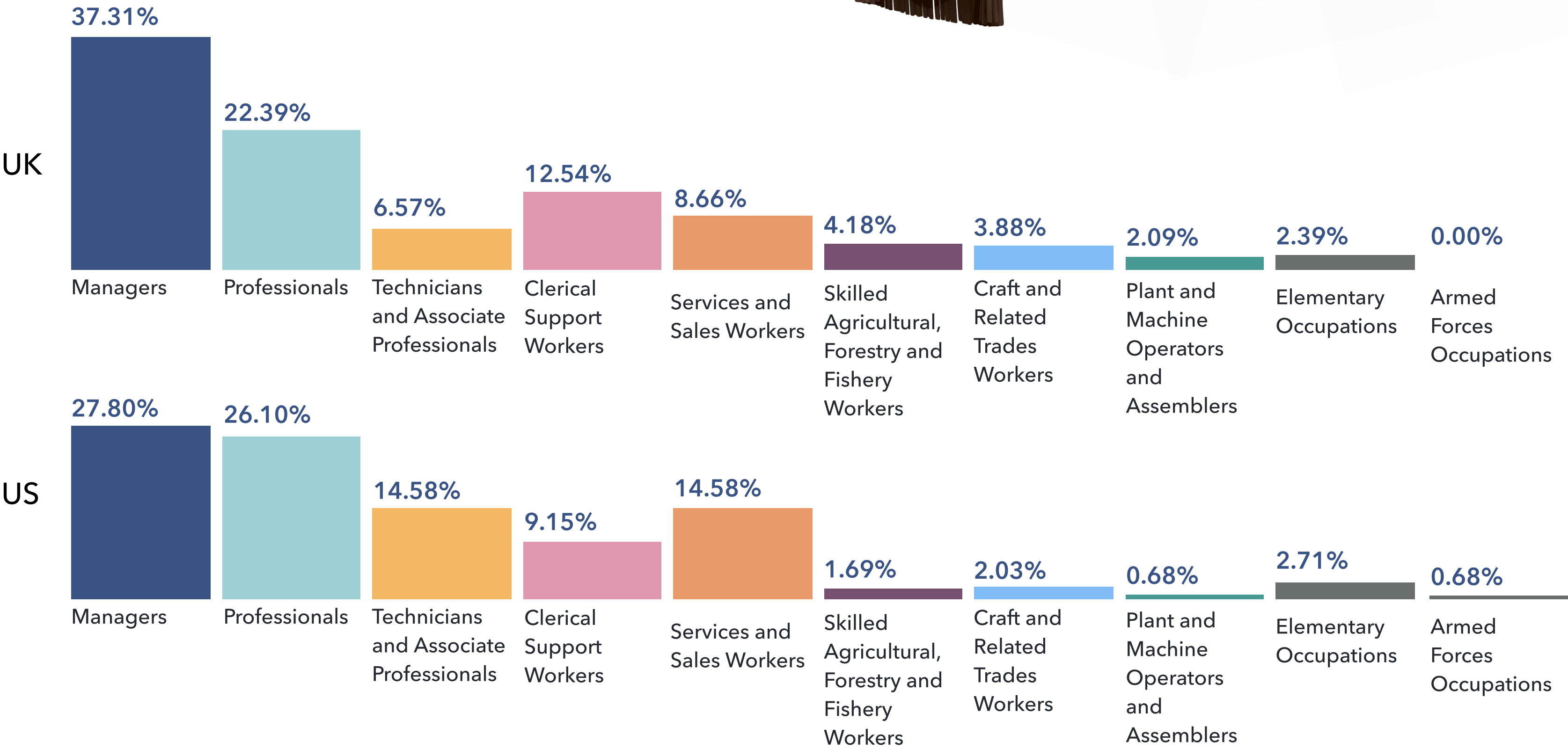
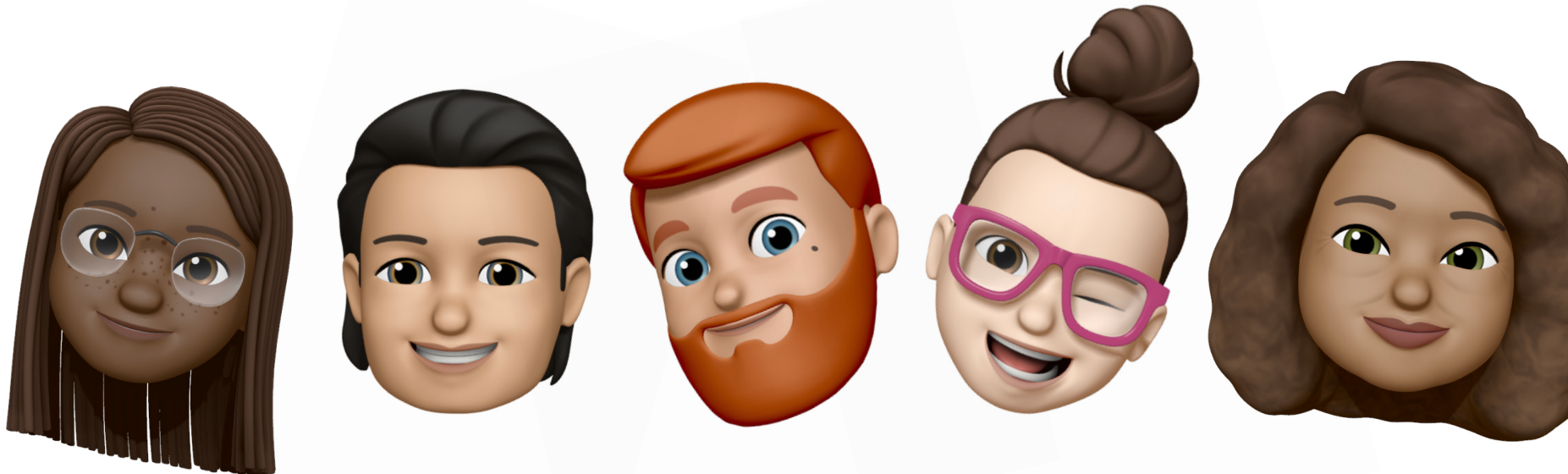

Region



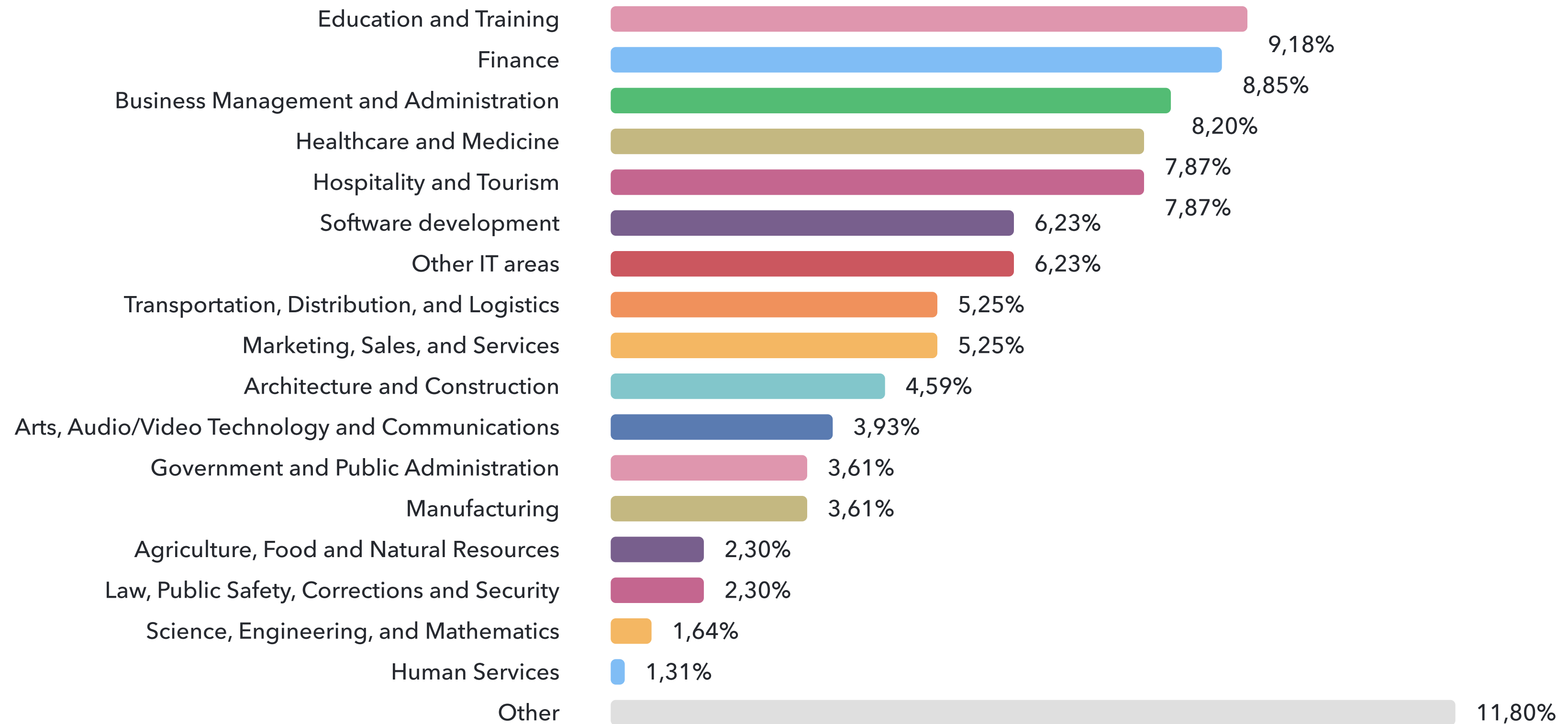

What is your current position?



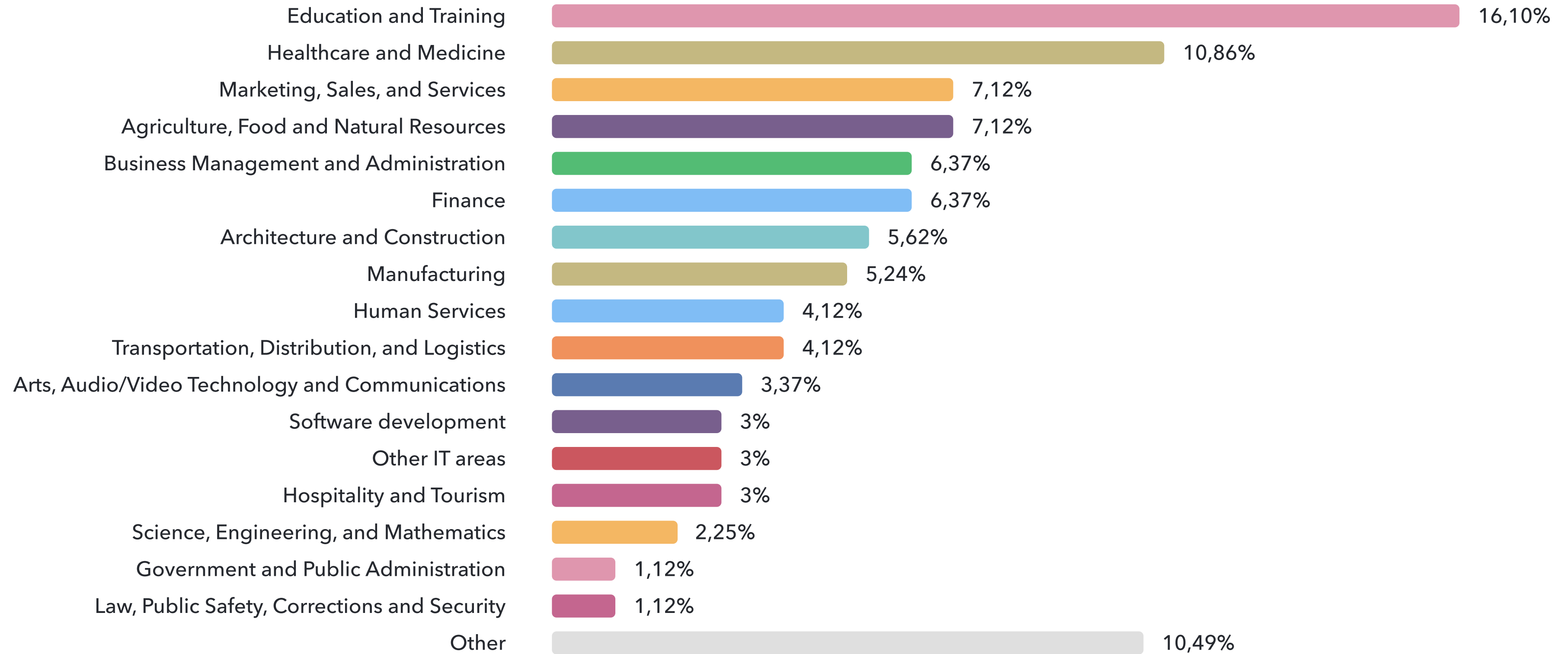
